**** MCC # 8-212. Interference with public health, safety, and morals prohibited, Zoning Restrictions, and Distance Requirements.** No permit authorizing the sale of beer will be issued when such business would cause traffic congestion or would interfere with schools, churches, or other places of public gatherings, or would otherwise interfere with the public health, safety, and morals. Permits may be issued only to otherwise qualifying applicants with businesses in Zones B- 1, B-2 or B-3. Other than on Main Street, in no event will a permit be issued authorizing the storage, sale, or manufacture of beer at places within four hundred (400) feet of any school, church, or other place of public gathering which has preexisted the application date of the permit sought by six (6) continuous months, measured along street rights of-way and from nearest boundary line to nearest boundary line.

I am knowledgeable of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors. I hereby certify that no person having at least a 5% ownership interest, nor any person to be employed in the distribution or sale of beer in my establishment has been convicted of any violation of the beer or alcoholic beverage laws or any crime involving moral turpitude within the past 10 years. I am also aware that I shall not be issued a permit or my permit shall be revoked if my business location causes traffic congestion or interferes with schools, churches, or other places of public gathering, or otherwise interferes with public health, safety and morals.

NOTICE

Fees and Taxes. The following fees and taxes shall apply:

- (1) Each applicant for a permit shall be required to pay an application fee of Two Hundred Fifty dollars (\$250.00). No portion of the fee shall be refunded to the applicant notwithstanding whether an application is approved or denied.
- (2) There is hereby imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer, an annual privilege tax of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

1. Any person, firm, corporation, joint-stock company, syndicate or association engaged in selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer shall remit the tax on January 1, 2003, and each successive January 1. The tax shall be remitted to the City Recorder.

INSTRUCTION SHEET

Permits shall be issued to the owner of the business, whether a person, firm, corporation, joint-stock company, syndicate, or association.

A permit is only for a single location and is valid for all decks, patios, and other outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located.

Where an owner operates two or more restaurants or other businesses within the same building, the owner may, in his or her discretion, operate some or all of such businesses under the same permit.

A permit is valid only for the business of the owner named in the permit.

A permit holder must return said permit to The Town of Mount Carmel within fifteen (15) days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business name. A change in ownership occurs for a corporate owner when at least fifty percent (50%) of the stock of the corporation is transferred to a new owner.

HOURS NOT PERMITTED

No licensee shall permit the sale of beer between the hours of 3 a.m. and 8 a.m. on Monday through Saturday or between the hours of 3 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Sunday.
