A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, SUPPORTING HAWKINS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) WITH AN IN-KIND DONATION OF RENT FOR A MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel recognizes the essential first responder services provided by Hawkins County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in safeguarding the health, safety, and welfare of its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, Hawkins County EMS has demonstrated a consistent and vital presence in responding to medical and traumatic emergencies within the town, contributing to the overall well-being of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel wishes to assist Hawkins County EMS in maintaining and enhancing their operational capacity to serve the public efficiently and effectively in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel has identified a suitable municipal building to provide as a location for Hawkins County EMS, which will support their continued operations within the town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel proposes to continue donating in-kind rent for the use of said building, valued at approximately \$2,000 monthly, to further support Hawkins County EMS services in the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Support for Hawkins County EMS: The Town of Mount Carmel hereby expresses its full support for Hawkins County EMS and acknowledges the essential role they play in the provision of emergency medical services to the town's residents.
- 2. In-Kind Donation: The Town of Mount Carmel agrees to continue providing an in-kind donation in the form of rent for a municipal building to be utilized by Hawkins County EMS. This donation is valued at approximately \$2,000 per month.
- 3. Terms and Conditions: The terms of the building's use by Hawkins County EMS shall be detailed in a mutually agreed-upon lease or use agreement, which will outline the responsibilities of both the Town and Hawkins County EMS in relation to the building's maintenance, utilities, and other pertinent matters.
- 4. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
