

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE,  
REGULATING LOITERING AND WANDERING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF  
THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

From and hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person  
or persons to wander about the streets, alleys, or other public  
ways or places within the corporate limits of the Town of Mount  
Carmel, without any visible or lawful business, and not giving a  
satisfactory account of themselves.

SECTION TWO

From and hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person  
to loiter or wander upon the public streets or alleys within the  
corporate limits of the Town of Mount Carmel, or within any place  
of business, or other public place in said town, between the hours  
of 11:00 o'clock P.M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M., eastern standard time.

SECTION THREE

Be it further ordained that the violation of this ordi-  
nance shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not  
less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00.

SECTION FOUR

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent  
with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby  
repealed.

SECTION SIX

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after its passage, as provided by law.

Passed and finally approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel on this the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1964.
