

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING POOL ROOMS AND POOL ROOM ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED AND ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE:

Section I. Hours of operation regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person to open, maintain, conduct, or operate any establishment where pool tables or billiard tables or other amusement devices known as pinball machines are kept for public use or hire at any time on Sunday, on legal holidays, or between the hours of 12:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock A.M. on other days.

Section II. Minors to be kept out; exception. It shall be unlawful for any person engaged regularly, or otherwise, in keeping billiard, bagatelle, or pool rooms or tables, their employees, agents, servants, or other persons for them, knowingly to permit any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to play on said tables at any game of billiards, bagatelle, pool, or other games requiring the use of cue and balls, and amusement devices known as pinball machines, without first having obtained the written consent of the father and mother of such minor, if living; if the father is dead, then the mother, guardian, or other person having legal control of such minor; or if the minor be in attendance as a student at some literary institution, then the written consent of the principal or person in charge of such school; provided that this section shall not apply to the use of billiards, bagatelle, and pool tables in private residences.

Section III. Gambling, etc., not to be allowed. It shall be unlawful for any person operating, conducting, or

maintaining any place where pool tables, or billiard tables, or pinball machines are kept for public use or hire, to permit any gambling or other unlawful or immoral conduct on such premises.
