

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15 WHICH GRANTED TO COMMUNITY ELECTRONIC SERVICE, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS (WARNER CABLE CORP.) A FRANCHISE

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the town of Mount Carmel by Ordinance No. 15 granted to Community Electronic Service, Inc., a franchise to engage in the business of and to operate a television cable service at a specified rate as set out in Section 3 therein; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 15 was amended in relevant part by Ordinance No. 59 by deleting from Section 3 therein the words "that the rates will not exceed Five (\$5.00) Dollars per month per set connected" and by substituting in part the following: "A. That effective July 1, 1975, the monthly service rates will be Seven Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$7.25) for the first outlet and One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for each additional outlet thereafter;" and

WHEREAS, the regional franchisee has been succeeded by and franchise assigned to Warner Cable Corp. and that it appears that the cost of providing cable service has increased and that the franchisee's manager has made representations of improving the quality and availability of cable service to the citizens of the town of Mount Carmel such as it appears to the said Board that the franchise rates should be increased by the sum of Fifty-Five Cents (\$.55) per month for monthly service effective March 1, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee that said Ordinance No. 59 is amended by deleting from Section 1. A. therein the words reading: "A. That effective July 1, 1975, the monthly service rates will be Seven Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents

(\$7.25) for the first outlet and One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for each additional outlet thereafter;" and by substituting the following provisions in its place:

"A. That effective March 1, 1979, the monthly service rates will be Seven Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$7.80) for the first outlet and One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for each additional outlet thereafter."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance should be effective from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
