BEGINNING at a point, said point being in the northeasterly corner of Mount Carmel, and also being the intersection of Carter's Valley Road with Oakland Avenue; thence from said point in a westerly direction following the southerly right-of-way of Carter's Valley Road for a distance of approximately 5,900 feet to a point, said point being approximately 550 feet west of the intersection of Carter's Valley Road with Independence Avenue; thence in a southerly direction for approximately 200 feet; thence turning in an easterly direction and paralleling Carter's Valley Road at a distance of 200 feet for approximately 5,900 feet to a point, said point being in the westerly right-of-way of

Oakland Avenue; thence from said point in a northerly direction for 200 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
