Ordinance # 89

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY AND TO INCORPORATE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, a public hearing before this body was held on the  $\frac{26}{100}$  day of  $\frac{26}{100}$ , 1987, and notice thereof published in the "Kingsport Times" on  $\frac{26}{100}$ ; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the prosperity of this town and of the territory herein described will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property thereof endangered if such territory is not annexed; and

WHEREAS, the annexation of such territory is deemed necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners thereof and of this town as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee:

Section 1. Pursuant to authority conferred by Section 6-51-102 through 6-51-302 of the <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, there is hereby annexed to the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and incorporated within the corporate boundaries thereof, the following described territory adjoining the present corporate boundaries:


BEGINNING at a point, said point being the intersection of the eastern corporate boundary of Mount Carmel that parallels McCracken Lane and the southern right-of-way of the Southern Railroad; thence with said point in a southeasterly direction and running with the Mount Carmel corporate limits for a distance of approximately 2,360 feet to a point, said point being the southern most point of Parcel Number 12, Block C, as shown on Map 12, insert J of the Hawkins County Tax Maps dated May 1986; thence in an easterly direction and running with the southern property lines of Parcels 13, 14, 17 and 19 for approximately 1,507 feet to a point, said point being the southeastern corner of Parcel 19, Block C, as shown on Map 12, insert G of the Hawkins County Tax Maps; thence continuing said line in an easterly direction and running with the southern property line of Parcel 98 for approximately 2,680 feet to a point, said point being the southeastern corner of Parcel 98 as shown on Map 12 of the Hawkins County Tax Map; thence in a northerly direction and meandering with the eastern boundary of Parcel 98 for approximately 3,605 feet to a point, said point being the northeastern corner of Parcel 98 at its intersection with the southern right-ofway of the Southern Railroad; thence with the southern right-of-way of the Southern Railroad in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approximately 11,300 feet to a point, said point being the point of BEGINNING.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after its passage, or as otherwise provided by law.

Section 3. There is attached thereto and made a part hereof a section of Hawkins County Tax Map 12 with inserts.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ON ANNEXATION COSTS AND BENEFITS

#### Cost

The annexation of Brookshire Hills will not cost residents because Mt. Carmel does not have a property tax. The town will receive additional state and federal shared revenue based on the population of Brookshire Hills.

#### Benefits

<u>Police</u> - Police protection will be provided by Mt. Carmel instead of the Hawkins County Sheriff.

Fire - Fire protection will be provided by Mt. Carmel instead of the East Hawkins County Volunteer Fire Department located in Church Hill. The Mt. Carmel volunteer fire department can no longer serve residents outside the town because of restrictions on vehicle insurance.

Refuse - Regular refuse collection will be provided by the town which will save residents about \$90.00 a year.

Streets - Street maintenance will be provided by Mt. Carmel instead of Hawkins County.

Street Lights - Current deed restrictions may make it difficult to provide street lights. Street lights will be provided if residents approve a cost effective street light.

Building Code, Planning and Zoning - Building code, planning and zoning regulations will be provided.

Recreation - All recreation services and facilities will be available.

Water - Water is currently provided by the First Hawkins County Utility District which will not be changed.

<u>Sewers</u> - Sanitary sewer will not be available in Phase I, but will be included in Phase II or III which are dependent on grant funds and cost effectiveness.

Signs - Traffic control signs and street signs will be provided.

Government - Brookshire Hills residences will have the right to vote and participate in town government.

<u>Cable TV</u> - The town will allow the cable TV company to use town street right-of-way to install their cable underground. The town will do all that it can to ensure that the cable TV company extends service to Brookshire Hills.



#### RESTRICTIONS

The property here conveyed is restricted as to use and occupancy, as follows:

- A. Same shall be used for residential purposes only, and all dwellings constructed thereon must have a minimum of 1200 sq. feet of floor space on the first floor, exclusive of garage or carport. Metal roofs are not permitted. Block stucco, or construction with visible block in outside walls are forbidden.
- B. No trailer, basement, tent, shack, temporary structure, or garage or other dwelling shall, at any time, be used as a residence, either temporarily or permanently.
- C. No animals or poultry of any kind (other than household pets) shall be kept or maintained upon any part of said property. The keeping or maintaining of household pets for commercial purposes is also forbidden.
- D. Any and all accessory buildings constructed upon said property shall be of the same construction and general appearance as is the residence.
- E. Gardens are not permitted within 75 feet of the front lot line. No shrubs or fences shall be erected or planted in such a way as that they shall obstruct the view of the public road, or road intersection.
- F. Upon the digging of any basement or foundation, a tile must be installed at the proposed driveway to said property.
- G. Sanitary sewage disposal shall be installed upon said lot, or lots, and shall in all respects conform to, and be approved in writing by, the Hawkins County Health Department.
- H. No building shall be constructed nearer than 35 feet from front lot line or nearer than 10 feet from the adjoining lot lines on the sides; PROVIDED that in case one owner acquires more than one adjacent lot, this restriction shall be applicable to the outside sidelines only.
- It is the responsibility of the owner to keep lots moved, and cleared of underbrush and rubbish.

By the acceptance of this deed, the purchasers hereby agree to and become fully bound by these restrictions, which shall be deemed and treated as convenants running with the land. Sellers agree that similar restrictions shall be contained in all other deeds for lots within this subdivision.
