

Ordinance #93

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY AND TO INCORPORATE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, a public hearing before this body was held on the 28th day of January, 1988, and notice thereof published in the "Kingsport Times" on December 22, 1987; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the prosperity of this town and of the territory herein described will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property thereof endangered if such territory is not annexed; and

WHEREAS, the annexation of such territory is deemed necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners thereof and of this town as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee:

Section 1. Pursuant to authority conferred by Section 6-51-102 through 6-51-302 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, there is hereby annexed to the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and incorporated within the corporate boundaries thereof, the following described territory adjoining the present corporate boundaries:

Being two parcels of land lying on the north side of Hammond Avenue adjoining the western corporate limits and further described as that portion of parcel 77.05 lying outside the corporate limits and all of parcel 77.06 plus that portion of Hammond Avenue adjoining parcels 77.05 and 77.06 that is outside the corporate limits. These parcels are shown on Hawkins County Tax Map 21 dated May 1986.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after its passage, or as otherwise provided by law.

Section 3. There is attached thereto and made a part hereof a portion of tax map 21 showing this area.
