ORDINANCE NO. <u>∂∂</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 14, "PLANNING AND ZONING", CHAPTER 4 "DEFINITIONS".

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee Municipal Planning Commission hears numerous requests in its role as the Board of Zoning Appeals for setback variances; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee Municipal Planning Commission has recommended a refinement in the definition of "setbacks" as stated in the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the public health and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, require it;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION I. That the Mount Carmel, Tennessee, Municipal Code section 14-401 "Use of Terms", shall have added thereto the following sub-section entitled "Setbacks" in appropriate alphabetic order and each sub-section thereafter shall be renumbered accordingly:

- 25. Setbacks. The following rules shall apply in determining setbacks:
- (a) All buildings including porches, carport covers, garages and swimming pools shall meet the minimum setback requirements for the zoning district where they are located. Driveways must beat least 2.5 feet from the rear and side property lines. Patios and walks at ground level around swimming pools must be at least 7.5 feet from the rear and side property lines. Also, swimming pools, including walks at ground level, must meet the front yard setback requirements. Overhangs of two feet or less will be exempt from the setback requirements.
- (b) Setbacks for customary accessory buildings are specified in Section 14-1001.
- (c) Front and rear raised and covered entrances six feet deep by eight feet wide or less are exempt from the front and rear setback requirements.

SECTION II. LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
- C. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
