

ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 15, "MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAFFIC AND PARKING," CHAPTER SEVEN, "ENFORCEMENT" OF THE MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Mount Carmel Code Title 15, Chapter 7, provides for the Motor Vehicle, Traffic and Parking, rules and regulations for the purpose of enforcement; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Article VI Section 14 of the Tennessee Constitution by applying the standard that "no fine shall be laid on any citizen of this State that shall exceed fifty dollars, unless it shall be assessed by a jury of his peers, who shall assess the fine at the time they find the fact, if they think the fine should be more than fifty dollars"; and

WHEREAS, these changes are needed pursuant to the recent Supreme Court decision regarding Article VI, Section 14 of the Tennessee Constitution in The City Of Chattanooga v. Kevin Davis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION I. That the Mount Carmel Municipal Code be amended by deleting Title 15, "Motor Vehicles, Traffic and Parking, " Chapter 7, Section 15-703, Illegal Parking, and in its place, substituting the following:

15-703 Illegal Parking. Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked or stopped in violation of any of the restrictions imposed by this code, the officer finding such vehicle shall take its license number and may take any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a citation for the driver and/or owner to answer for the violation within thirty (30) days during the hours and at a place specified in the citation.

The offender may, within thirty (30) days, have the charge against him disposed of by paying to the town recorder a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) provided he waives his right to a judicial hearing . If he appears and waives his right to a judicial hearing after (30) days, but before a warrant for his arrest is issued, his fine shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00). If tried and convicted, his fine shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) only if done so in front of a jury of his peers.

SECTION II. LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS.

A. Conflict With Other Ordinances. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.

B. Validity. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.

C. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
