### ORDINANCE NO. 234

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 16, "STREETS, SIDEWALKS, ETC.," CHAPTER TWO, "EXCAVATIONS" OF THE MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE.

- WHEREAS, Mount Carmel Code Title 16, Chapter 2, provides for the Streets and Sidewalks, Etc., rules and regulations for the purpose of enforcement; and
- WHEREAS, in order to comply with Article VI, Section 14 of the Tennessee Constitution by applying the standard that "no fine shall be laid on any citizen of this State that shall exceed fifty dollars, unless it shall be assessed by a jury of his peers, who shall assess the fine at the time they find the fact, if they think the fine should be more than fifty dollars"; and
- WHEREAS, these changes are needed pursuant to the recent Supreme Court decision regarding Article VI, Section 14 of the Tennessee Constitution in <a href="The City Of Chattanooga v. Kevin Davis">The City Of Chattanooga v. Kevin Davis</a>.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

**SECTION I.** That the Mount Carmel Municipal Code be amended by deleting Title 16, "Streets and Sidewalks, Etc." Chapter 2, Section 16-206. <u>Restoration of Streets, etc.</u>, and in its place, substituting the following:

16-206 Restoration of Streets, etc. Any person, firm, corporation, association, or others making any excavation or tunnel in or under any right-of-way, street, alley, or public place in the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, shall restore the right-of-way, street, alley, or public place to its original condition. In the case of unreasonable delay in restoring the right-of-way, street, alley, or public place, the Town Recorder shall give notice to the person, firm, corporation, association or others that unless the excavation or tunnel is refilled properly according to Town specifications within a specified reasonable amount of time, and, if applicable, the resurfacing restored to its original condition, all within a specified reasonable time period, the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, may elect to do the refilling and resurfacing work and charge the expense of doing the same to such person, firm, corporation, association, or others including a twenty percent (20%) premium charge due to the administration expense and expenditure of time. If within the specified time, the condition of the above notice have not been complied with, the work shall be done by the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, an accurate account of the expense involved shall be kept, and the total costs plus the twenty percent (20%) premium shall be charged to the person, firm, corporation, association, or others who made the excavation or tunnel. This remedy may be in lieu of, or, in addition to, any other fines provided under this chapter. However, any person, firm, corporation, association, or others making any excavation or tunnel in or under any right-of-way, street, alley, or public place in the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, shall notify the Building Inspector who shall inspect the excavation or tunnel and its restoration to see that such excavation or tunnel and its restoration complies with all applicable rules and regulations and to see that it is properly restored with adequate gravel, back fill, and properly resurfaced. Any such person, firm, corporation, association, or others restoring any excavation or tunnel are subject to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day for each and every day that the excavation or tunnel is restored without the Building Inspector having approved the restoration of the excavation or tunnel.

#### **SECTION II.** LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.

C. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
