### **ORDINANCE NO. 283**

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A HEALTH INSURANCE OPTION IN LIEU OF GROUP SINGLE HEALTH INSURANCE

- WHEREAS, the cost of health insurance continues to increase significantly each year, and the increased cost is making health insurance prohibitively expensive for the Town of Mount Carmel; and
- WHEREAS, the Town has considered several options in order to contain costs, and it seems that a week of paid vacation in lieu of health insurance is the most practical option for cutting health insurance cost; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel as follows:

**SECTION I.** Employees of the Town of Mount Carmel, who are currently enrolled in the Town's group health insurance plan, are entitled to choose one of two options with respect to health insurance:

- 1. Continue single health coverage under the town's group health insurance plan; or
- 2. Decline group single health coverage and receive one week of paid vacation for the following year to be reviewed annually by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen at its December Meeting.

**SECTION II.** Nothing in this ordinance requires the Town of Mount Carmel to provide health insurance for its employees and their dependents. The health insurance vacation allowance is entirely dependent upon the town's decision to provide health insurance as a fringe benefit and upon the town's annual budget.

**SECTION III.** This ordinance shall become effective upon final passage, the public welfare requiring it.

#### SECTION IV. Legal Status Provisions.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
- C. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
