

ORDINANCE NO. 295

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 6, "LAW ENFORCEMENT" CHAPTER ONE, "POLICE AND ARREST" SECTION 105 "POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL 2005" OF THE MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE; AND FIX THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION I. That section 6-105 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-105. Police Department Policies and Procedures Manual 2005. The Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee Police Department Policies and Procedures Manual 2005 and included in these Policies and Procedures the Mount Carmel Animal Control Policies and the Mount Carmel Evidence Handling Procedures is hereby adopted by reference and included as a part of this Code as the official policy of the Town of Mount Carmel Police Department and all approved amendments thereto, and is to be used by all members and employees of the Mount Carmel Police Department in carrying out the duties, responsibilities, and obligations imposed upon them by law of necessarily assumed in carrying out the department's objectives.

SECTION II. Any other Resolution or Ordinance presently in existence which in any way conflicts with any provision of this Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual is superseded and therefore repealed.

SECTION VI. LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS.

A. Conflict With Other Ordinances. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.

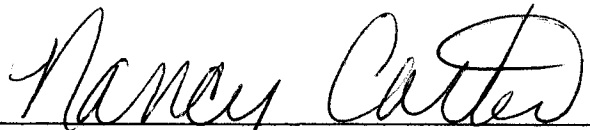
B. Validity. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.

C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.

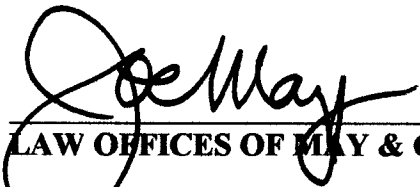
