ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1 "GENERAL ADMINISTRATION", CHAPTER 1 "BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN", SECTION 104 "COMPENSATION", OF THE MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE; AND TO FIX THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen as follows:

SECTION I. That Section 104, Compensation, of Title 1, GENERAL ADMINISTRATION, Chapter 1, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, of the Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

1-104. <u>Compensation.</u> In accordance with *Tenn. Code Anno.* §6-3-109, the compensation of the board of mayor and aldermen shall be established in the ordinance adopting the annual budget and capital program. The compensation of the mayor may not be diminished during the mayor's term of office.

SECTION II. Legal Status Provisions.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.

C. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
