- WHEREAS, expenses for General Government, Financial Administration, Public Safety, Public Works, Solid Waste, Parks and Recreation and Library expenditures will be greater than anticipated; and
- WHEREAS, Tax Revenue, Intergovernmental Revenues, Fines & Forfeitures, and Miscellaneous Revenues are housed within the General Fund for the Town.
- WHEREAS, the expenses for General Government. Financial Administration, Public Safety, Public Works, Solid Waste, Parks and Recreation and Library are housed within the General Fund for the Town; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE THAT CHANGES BE MADE TO THE FISCAL YEAR 18-19 BUDGET AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 2. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the City Recorder to make said changes in the accounting system.
