



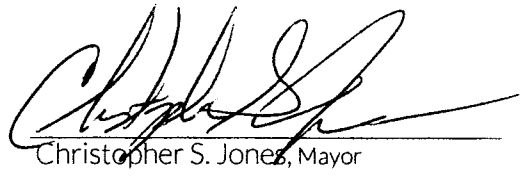
ORDINANCE NO. 19-491
TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE
AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT
CARMEL, TENNESSEE ESTABLISHING A BULK
WASTE AND LARGE ITEM COLLECTION POLICY

- WHEREAS, the removal of bulk waste presents a potential hazard to those operating vehicles on the streets of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and;
- WHEREAS, the removal of such bulk waste presents a fiscal hardship for the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and;
- WHEREAS, the current procedure for the removal of such bulk waste results in a gross mismanagement of the time of the employees of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and;
- WHEREAS, the regulation of such bulk waste removal is necessary in order to appropriately manage the resources allocated for waste pick-up:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

- SECTION I. Special collection of unusual, heavy, bulky or hazardous materials, including but not limited to: certain household items and appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, water tanks, washing machines, dryers, furniture, mattresses, bedsprings and air conditioners shall be collected by the town on the fourth week of each month basis as follows:
- (a) The property owner or resident shall call the department of public works and shall request that such items be picked up prior to placing those items at curbside or any other location as directed by the director of the department of public works.
 - (b) Special collection of these items will be made by the town on the property owner or resident's property at curbside on a public right of way only to the extent that such special collection can be made safely by city personnel in one truck and in one trip, using the grapple of the city collection vehicle. The removal of any whole or part of such material that the town determines it cannot safely remove according to the terms and limitations of this sub-section shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner or resident.
 - (c) A fee established by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen may be charged for this service.
- SECTION II. Unusual, heavy, bulky or hazardous materials as defined in Section 1, shall not be placed at the street for collection until the day before it is scheduled to be picked up. Violation of this time restriction shall result in a fine of up to \$50 per occurrence, except at those times where such violation of the time restriction results from the Town of Mount Carmel's inability to make the scheduled pick-up at the designated time due to high volumes of requests.
- SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.

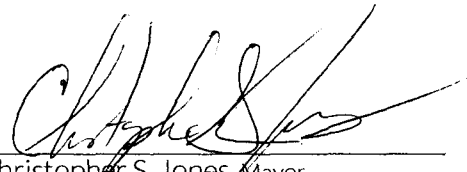

- SECTION II. Prohibited items shall include tires, rims, vehicle parts, batteries, paint, bricks, construction materials, concrete, shingles, and any other items as established by the Hawkins County Landfill.
- SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
