

ORDINANCE NO. 21-506 TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL TENNESSEE LOWERING THE SPEED LIMIT ON MAIN STREET IN THE AREA IN FRONT OF CITY HALL

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town Mount Carmel is interested in establishing safe speed limits for vehicles and pedestrians in the Town, and

WHEREAS, the area in front of City Hall is unsafe when vehicles are traveling at 30 miles per hour, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is presently established a maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour for all of Main Street, except as provided below.

Section 2. There is established a maximum speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Main Street beginning at the intersection of Hammond Avenue and Main Street and extending for 550 feet in the direction of Independence Avenue.

Section 3. A penalty of \$140 shall be imposed for each violation of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage and the posting of appropriate signs, the public welfare requiring it.
