



ORDINANCE NO. 22-510  
TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL TENNESSEE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 PASSED BY ORDINANCE NO. 21-502

- WHEREAS the Town of Mount Carmel adopted the fiscal year 2021-2022 Budget by passage of Ordinance No. 21-302 on June 24, 2021; and
- WHEREAS pursuant to the Tennessee state constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and
- WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the *Tennessee Code Annotated* §6-56-209, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has the authority to authorize the budget officer to transfer moneys from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and
- WHEREAS Miscellaneous Revenues for the General Fund and Sewer Fund will be greater than anticipated; and
- WHEREAS expenses for General Government, Financial Administration, Police Department, Library, and Recreation Department; Sewer Fund expenditures will be greater than anticipated; and
- WHEREAS Miscellaneous Revenues are housed within the General Fund for the Town; Miscellaneous Revenues are housed within the Sewer Fund for the Town; and
- WHEREAS the expenses for General Government, Financial Administration, Public Safety, Public Works, Solid Waste, Parks and Recreation and Library are housed within the General Fund for the Town; Pump Station Repair and Maintenance and Wastewater Repair and Maintenance are housed in the Sewer Fund for the Town; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE THAT CHANGES BE MADE TO THE FISCAL YEAR 21-22 BUDGET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 21-502 is hereby amended by increasing General Government expenditures by \$15,000; by increasing Financial Administration expenditures by \$272,550; Police Department expenditures by \$10,000; by increasing Library expenditures by \$10,000; and increasing Recreation expenditures by \$72,921; by increasing Misc. Revenue by \$380,471; by increasing Sewer expenditures by \$147,074; and by increasing Sewer Revenues by \$147,074.

SECTION 2. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the City Recorder to make said changes in the accounting system

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
