

RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee that

WHEREAS, the Honorable Tom Dean has given long and faithful service to the Town of Mount Carmel, having served as Alderman since the incorporation of the Town in 1961 until 1965, and having served as Mayor of Mount Carmel from 1966 until October 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel has made great progress during this period of time, thanks in part to the efforts, dedication and leadership of the Honorable Tom Dean in that during this period of time all the streets in the City were paved, street lights were erected, City Hall property was purchased, a City Recreational Park was developed, a new City Hall was built, a library was built, the 11-W Motors property was purchased for use as a Police & Fire Hall, the City hired one full-time policeman and two part-time policemen, and the widening and repairing of Montgomery Street in connection with the City of Church Hill was begun and almost completed, all of which has contributed to the health, safety and well being of the citizens of Mount Carmel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Mayor and Aldermen express our appreciation to the Honorable Tom Dean for the work, leadership and inspiration that he has provided to the Board of Aldermen and to the citizens of the Town of Mount Carmel, and commend him for a job well done. This Board of Mayor and Aldermen further requests of the Honorable Tom Dean that he continue to actively participate in the affairs of the Town of Mount Carmel as a private citizen and that he contribute his wisdom and experience wherever and however they may be needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution take effect immediately, the public welfare requiring it.
