EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN  
OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE  
HELD ON JANUARY 14, 1988

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Hawkins County, Tennessee, met in special, public session at the Town Hall in Mount Carmel, Tennessee, its regular meeting place, at 7:15 o'clock p.m., local time, on the 14th day of January, 1988, the Honorable Gary Lawson presiding and the following named members of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen present:

The following Resolution was thereupon introduced and read in full:

RESOLUTION NO. 1

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$3,400,000 SEWER REVENUE AND TAX BONDS, SERIES 1988 OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR A SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND THE INCIDENTAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest of the Town of Mount Carmel, Hawkins County, Tennessee (the "Municipality") to issue Sewer Revenue and Tax Bonds, Series 1988 (the "Bonds") for the purpose of funding a portion of the costs of constructing and equipping a municipal sanitary sewer collection system and wastewater treatment plant, to retire short-term indebtedness the proceeds of which were used to pay a portion of the costs of

constructing said system, and for the defrayment of all incidental and necessary expenses in connection therewith.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of financing a portion of the costs of constructing and equipping public works projects, including constructing and equipping a municipal sanitary sewer collection system and wastewater treatment plant (the "Project"); the acquisition of all property, real and personal, appurtenant thereto or connected with such work; to retire short-term indebtedness the proceeds of which were used to pay a portion of the costs of construction of the Project; and to pay legal, fiscal, administrative, and engineering costs incident thereto, and costs incident to the issuance and sale of the Bonds, the issuance of the Bonds of the Municipality in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,400,000) is hereby authorized. The Bonds shall be issued at a date, at a rate of interest not in excess of eleven percent (11%) per annum, and upon terms and conditions to be later determined.

SECTION 2: That principal of and interest on the Bonds, shall be payable from revenues of the Project and in the event such revenues are insufficient therefor from ad valorem taxes to be levied for such purpose on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Municipality, without limitation as to rate and amount and for the punctual payment of the principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds, the full faith and credit of the Municipality will be irrevocably pledged.

SECTION 3: That the Bonds described and authorized by this Resolution shall be issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1 and 2, Tennessee Code

Annotated, as amended, (the "Act"), and no referendum or election shall be required for the issuance of the Bonds unless a petition for a referendum election relating to their issuance is filed within the time and in the manner provided for in said Act.

SECTION 4: That after the adoption of this Resolution, the City Recorder is directed to cause this Resolution, with the notice prescribed by the Act, to be published in full once in a newspaper published and having general circulation in the area of the Municipality.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Municipality requiring it.

NOTICE

The foregoing Resolution has been adopted. Unless within ten (10) days from the date of publication hereof a petition, signed by at least ten percent (10%) of the registered voters of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, shall have been filed with the City Recorder protesting the issuance of the Bonds, such Bonds will be issued as proposed.

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(Other Business)

There being no further business, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously adopted, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, adjourned.
