

RESOLUTION 55

APPROVING MUNICIPAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY SERVICE
(MTAS) STUDY OF AREAS FOR MUTUAL COOPERATION
BETWEEN KINGSPORT AND MT. CARMEL, TENNESSEE

Whereas, Kingsport and Mt. Carmel are neighboring towns sharing common borders, interests, geographic areas and populations; and

Whereas, benefits have been achieved for the citizens of the two towns from the mutual cooperation between the two towns; and

Whereas, it would be useful to identify, what, if any, areas exist for additional cooperation between the two towns; and

Whereas, MTAS has agreed to conduct such a study to identify these areas and the benefits from cooperation in these areas; and

Whereas, MTAS has agreed to conduct this study at no cost to either town; and

Whereas, the approval of conducting this study is neither an endorsement for or rejection of any efforts to further mutually cooperate between the two towns; and

Whereas, the information to be gained from such a study is necessary to intelligently make decisions as to the growth and future prosperity of the two towns and their citizens:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Municipal Technical Advisory Service is authorized to conduct the study as set forth above so long as it is done without cost to the town, the public welfare requiring it.
