The following resolution was introduced and read in full:

INITIAL RESOLUTION authorizing the issuance of a \$300,000 Sewer Revenue and Tax Bond, Series 1993A of Mount Carmel, Tennessee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Mount Carmel, Tennessee that for the purpose of financing in part the construction of essential public works or facilities, consisting of sewer system improvements and extensions, there shall be issued a bond of said municipality in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$300,000, which shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed six and one-quarter percent (6.25%) per annum, and which shall be payable from revenues of the sewer system, subject to prior lien bonds, and, in the event such revenues are insufficient therefor, from ad valorem taxes to be levied on all taxable property within the municipality.
