

RESOLUTION NO. 180

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL,  
TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CHIEF OF  
POLICE TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND DOCUMENTS TO  
ACCEPT COPS UNIVERSAL HIRING PROGRAM GRANT

WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee  
authorized the Chief of Police to apply for a COPS Universal Hiring Grant on the

28 day of May, 1998; and

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing  
Services has awarded the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, a COPS Universal  
Hiring Grant; and

WHEREAS, Under the terms and conditions of the United States Department of Justice, the  
signed grant award must be returned to the COPS Office within ninety (90) days  
and the grant must be accepted or declined within forty-five (45) days; and


WHEREAS, Mount Carmel Municipal Code §1-403 requires the Board of Mayor and  
Aldermen to approve all contracts which are to be signed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, The terms and conditions of the COPS Universal Hiring Program Grant are  
contained in the documents attached hereto and incorporated herein as exhibit A;  
and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen  
of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

- Section 1. That the Mayor and Chief of Police, as necessary, are authorized to execute all documents necessary to claim and receive the COPS Universal Hiring Program Grant awarded to the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, by the United States Department of Justice.
- Section 2. The Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, accepts the COPS Universal Hiring Program Grant and agrees to the commitments required of it under the terms and conditions of the Grant Award No. 1999 - UM-WX-2873.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.


