

**RESOLUTION NO. 188**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL,  
TENNESSEE, IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE  
BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has adopted budgets for the General Fund and the Sewer Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen wishes to state its policies for implementing provisions of each budget; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, that these policies shall be implemented by the Town's staff:

1. A pay raise of three percent (3%) shall be implemented on June 27, 1999, for all Town employees. Raises will be included in pay checks dated July 2, 1999. Raises will be granted to employees upon their supervisor's recommendations.
2. A pay schedule will be considered by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen in the middle of the fiscal year (January 2000) for possible adoption, depending on the Town's financial condition.
3. The Town's Purchasing, Travel, Personnel and other regulations shall be followed unless and until amended by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.
4. The Town's program of improving the condition of its neighborhoods by removing decrepit and dilapidated buildings shall be continued using these guidelines:
  - A. Only asbestos-free buildings will be considered for immediate removal.
  - B. Only buildings that can be torn down and hauled to the landfill by Town employees using Town owned equipment will be considered for immediate removal.

C. The Town's staff will cooperate with owners of buildings to upgrade their property before demolition is considered.

5. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.


