

RESOLUTION NO. 198

RESOLUTION ADOPTING RESERVE OFFICER POLICE MANUAL

WHEREAS, it is desirable to have rules, regulations, and procedures to guide and direct public safety reserve officers in the performance of their duties; and

WHEREAS, while it is impossible to provide a rule, regulation, or procedure for every situation to be confronted by a reserve public safety officer, it is still advantageous to provide general direction to such public safety officers; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and staff recommends approval and adoption of the attached police manual; and



SECTION I. The manual attached hereto and entitled "Reserve Officer Police Manual" should be and is hereby adopted as the official policy of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee;

SECTION II. All reserve public service officers shall be issued a copy of the attached manual and shall acknowledge receipt of same by affixing their signature to the "Confidential Security Information" section found at page 2 of said manual;


