RESOLUTION ADOPTING RESERVE OFFICER POLICE MANUAL


- WHEREAS, it is desirable to have rules, regulations, and procedures to guide and direct public safety reserve officers in the performance of their duties; and
- WHEREAS, while it is impossible to provide a rule, regulation, or procedure for every situation to be confronted by a reserve public safety officer, it is still advantageous to provide general direction to such public safety officers; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and staff recommends approval and adoption of the attached police manual; and
- WHEREAS, the public health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, will be materially enhanced by the adoption of said manual; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:


SECTION I. The manual attached hereto and entitled "Reserve Officer Police Manual" should be and is hereby adopted as the official policy of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee;

SECTION II. All reserve public service officers shall be issued a copy of the attached manual and shall acknowledge receipt of same by affixing their signature to the "Confidential Security Information" section found at page 2 of said manual;


