

## **RESOLUTION NO. 202**

### **RESOLUTION REQUESTING STATE REPRESENTATIVE KEN GIVENS, STATE SENATOR MIKE WILLIAMS, AND THE TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO INTRODUCE AND PASS LEGISLATION TO REPEAL PUBLIC CHAPTER 1101, THE SO-CALLED URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARY LAW.**

**WHEREAS**, Public Chapter 1101 was passed on May 29, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, it was designed to improve the process whereby communities may grow and prosper; and

**WHEREAS**, it was designed to allow cities, towns, and counties to work together to improve the public services provided their citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, these lofty goals have not been achieved, even with the full and wholehearted efforts of the citizens affected by Public Chapter 1101;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

| <b>SECTION I.</b>   | The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, request State Representative Ken Givens, State Senator Mike Williams, and the Tennessee General Assembly to repeal Public Chapter 1101 and allow municipalities to revert to their former rules and regulations which met the needs of our citizens in all respects. |
| <b>SECTION II.</b>  | The Mayor and Board of Aldermen request the Legislative Body of Hawkins County, and the Mayors and Boards of Aldermen of Church Hill, Rogersville, Surgoinsville, Bulls Gap and Kingsport to work together to assure the early and complete repeal of Public Chapter 1101.   |
| <b>SECTION III.</b> | The Mayor and Board of Aldermen request the Tennessee Municipal League to work with all Tennessee municipalities to assure the early and complete repeal of Public Chapter 1101.   |
| <b>SECTION IV.</b>  | The Mayor and Board of Aldermen request the Tennessee County Services Association to work with all Tennessee counties to assure the early and complete repeal of Public Chapter 1101.  |
| <b>SECTION V.</b>   | The City Recorder shall provide a copy of this Resolution to each of the officials and government bodies noted above.  |

**SECTION VI.**


This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.


