

RESOLUTION NO. 223

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES FOR LITTERING
IN THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL.**

WHEREAS, Mount Carmel Municipal Code, Title 11, "Municipal Offenses", Chapter 1, "Misdemeanors of State Adopted", Section 11-111, "Littering", provides that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen by Resolution may establish municipal court fines and costs for those persons cited into City Court, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, at this time wish to establish a maximum \$500.00 fine for littering; and

WHEREAS, The administration of justice and the public health and welfare require it;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:**

SECTION I. Until further amended by resolution, the schedule of municipal court fines and costs shall be amended as follows:


<u>OFFENSE</u>	<u>MAXIMUM FINE</u>	<u>COURT COSTS</u>	<u>TOTAL</u>
Littering or Disturbing Trash Containers	\$500.00	\$13.75	\$513.75

SECTION II. The municipal court fines and costs shall be adopted as of the effective date of this Resolution from and after its passage as the law directs, the public welfare requiring it.
