

## RESOLUTION NO. 257

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2002 BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS,** the safety and well being of the employees of the Town of Mount Carmel is of the greatest importance; and
- WHEREAS,** efforts should be made to provide protective body armor for the police officers of the Town of Mount Carmel; and
- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Justice Assistance Office seeks to be a responsive partner with state and local law enforcement agencies by offering a 2002 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program; and
- WHEREAS,** the Town of Mount Carmel now seeks to participate in this important program; and
- WHEREAS,** the public welfare requires it;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:**

- Section I.** That the Town of Mount Carmel is hereby authorized to apply for the 2002 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program and upon award, to accept same, and appropriately budget for its use;
- Section II.** The Town of Mount Carmel is further authorized to provide a matching sum not to exceed \$3,262.50, which represents the maximum federal funds available;
- Section III.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
